The Application

The Community Foundation uses an online grants platform called Grant Lifecycle Management (GLM). All applications must be submitted through this application process found on our website, <https://dccommunityfoundation.org/nonprofits/> via the [Online Application](#) link.

If you are new user, you will need to create an account using your e-mail address and a password. Once you start the, you can save your work throughout the process and come back to it later.

Eligibility

We encourage applications from 501(c)(3) nonprofits or other qualified tax-exempt organizations that serve Dubois County residents.

Limitations

The Community Foundation generally does not support the following:

- For-profit business-related programs or projects
- Loans or grants directly to individuals
- Golf scrambles, 5K, and other event sponsorships
- Booster/extracurricular clubs

Considerations

Financial commitment from the organization and other funding sources is important to show broad support and community buy-in.

Those applicants that are results driven, take a dignified, empowering approach to building a healthy community with effective partnerships will stand out.
